

Harley Davidson® offers members of military free riding academy training

Harley-Davidson®, long a big supporter of U.S. veterans, announced that it is extending free training at its riding academy through next year for members of the military. The program is now available to active-duty, retired, reservists and veterans. The free training was first offered earlier this year prior to Armed Forces Day aboard the USS Yorktown aircraft carrier in Charleston, S.C.

"Thousands of members of the military have learned to ride through the program so far," Christian Walters, Harley Davidson's® managing director and an Army Special Operations Aviation officer, said. "We're proud to extend this opportunity in 2016 so even more military personnel can enjoy the very freedom they protect.

Never ridden before? No problem. As the company says "Great riders aren't born They're made." The New Rider Course is designed to get newbies comfortable on a bike and ensure they have got the skills to get the license and start riding. The course features Harley-Davidson® certified coaches who will provide expert guidance. There are two primary components: classroom and on the range. The classroom section focus on rider safety skills basics and getting familiar with the motorcycle you will be riding. At the practice range, skills like braking, turning controlling skids and tackling obstacles are learned and practiced.

All members of the military who are stateside can take advantage of the offer by visiting a local Harley-Davidson® dealer or going to h-d.com/AmericanHeroes If a riding academy is not available in your particular area, then you can attend another certified motorcycle safety program and Harley-Davidson® will reimburse you. If you're currently abroad, then submit the form by December 31, 2016. The company will send you a voucher for free motorcycle safety training that can be used when you return home. It will be good through 2017.

Oakland U. donation benefits textbook program for vets

A \$20,000 donation to Oakland University will help expand the school's textbook loan program for student veterans and their dependents. The donation was made anonymously.

Launched earlier this year, the program encourages students, faculty and staff to donate gently used books in exchange for a T-shirt that reads "Support Our Veterans." The \$20,000 gift will fund the purchase of additional textbooks and support incentives for the program. The school says it has more than 300 veterans as students on campus.

Senate Ok's medical marijuana for veterans

For the first time, Veterans Health Administration doctors will be able to authorize medical marijuana use for patients. Just one day before veterans marched to the White House to lobby for medical marijuana as a treatment for war trauma, the Senate passed legislation allowing doctors to discuss medical cannabis as a treatment option for patients in 23 states.

The march began at D.C.'s Veterans Affairs Headquarters and headed down Pennsylvania Avenue to the White House. As part of the protest, the group of veterans threw thousands of empty prescription pill bottles onto the sidewalk. The bottles were collected from across the country in memory of those "whose sacrifices did not end on the battlefield."

Organizers said their goal was to raise awareness of dangerous prescription medications, which they say are often prescribed to treat war trauma. They say they're being unjustly deprived of cannabis therapy and with a current veteran suicide rate of 22 per day; it's time for the Veterans Administration to recognize that there are alternative forms of treatment available.

Before the new legislation, the Veterans Health Administration did not allow its physicians to discuss medical marijuana as an option for patients in states with medical cannabis laws, forcing veterans to turn elsewhere for guidance and the paperwork necessary to pursue treatment with the drug.

The Senate legislation won't change the federal illegality of using marijuana as medicine, but will allow veterans in states with medicinal marijuana legislation new options for the treatment of PTSD and other disabilities.

Mason County Veteran Receives Special Off-Road Wheelchair

A Northern Michigan veteran got a special outdoor, off-road wheelchair. Jesse Raymond tested out his action track chair at his home in Freesoil in Mason County. The retired Navy vet was diagnosed with multiple sclerosis in 2002.

Since then, it's been hard for him to get around, so he applied for the chair.

It comes complete with features he picked out, including a gun rack and fishing rod holder.

Raymond said the chair means a lot. "It's going to open up the outdoors again. I'm going to be able to hunt. You know hunting season opens in a couple of days, and I'll be able to be out there in the woods," says Raymond.

Raymond would have retired from the Navy next month, but he retired in 2003 because of the MS.

The Motorcycle Lawyer on THE LAW Jason's Top Three Tips for Renting a Motorcycle on Vacation

Happy New Year to all our fans! A new year means a new riding season, but for those of us in Michigan, we've got a few months left to wait before the weather allows us to get back out there. However, I know a lot of readers are planning a vacation this winter somewhere warm and sunny, and many are considering renting a motorcycle to ride while they're away. Here are my top three tips for those of you planning a motorcycle vacation, or looking for ways to incorporate motorcycling into your holiday plans.

Tip #1: Do your research. There are many, many factors to consider when talking about renting a motorcycle on vacation, and some are more obvious than others. For example, the first thing that probably comes to mind when thinking about renting a motorcycle is, "How much?" Price is obviously important, and it can be influenced by several factors, like the type of riding you want to do, what kind of bike you want to rent, and what destination(s) you'd like to reach. It's very important to choose a motorcycle that you can handle and that is appropriate for the kind of riding you want to do. You'll want to shop around to several rental locations to see who offers the best rates and what sorts of packages or discounts you can get for longer rentals. Remember, though, that it's not just a per-day rate you need to worry about; you may have to put down a deposit or pay an additional fee for passengers. You may also have to pay for mileage overages, any gear you want to rent, and of course, insurance.

Speaking of insurance, you will want to carefully research what type of coverage is mandatory, and what is recommended, in the state you are visiting. While you may be able to purchase insurance through the rental company, talk to your motorcycle insurance agent about your trip to find out what's available. Your agent may also recommend buying extra medical coverage, just in case. I also recommend doing some research into the motorcycling laws in the state you will be riding in. In particular, you should know: if there are age restrictions for rentals; if you need to have a motorcycle endorsement or special license; if bikers are permitted to ride side-by-side in the lane; and if motorcyclists (including passengers) are required to wear a crash helmet. Often, rental companies will have this information on their websites, or their staff can advise you when you call to book your reservation.

Tip #2: Plan ahead. While the rental industry is robust in most tourist destinations, you will want to make your reservation as far in advance of your trip as possible. Not only will this help ensure you get the bike you want (at the price you want!), it will also give you enough time to get your insurance sorted out, and generate a to-do list to help you prepare for your trip. Packing is important! If you are planning to ride only a few hours or a few days during your vacation, then you may want to rent a helmet or riding gear rather than bringing your own. But for a longer trip, you might want to have your own "tried and true" equipment. Some seasoned motorcycle vacationers recommend shipping clothing and other luggage to the hotel ahead of time; this would be especially convenient if you were picking up your rental at the airport. Some rental companies may also offer luggage storage, or have other options to help you manage your load on the bike

Have your destination(s) and route(s) planned out before you leave, so you're not wasting precious vacation time trying to decide where to go and how to get there. Again, many rental companies will give suggestions on their website, or you can talk to the staff about "must see" spots when you book your rental. They may also be able to help you figure out if your trip is feasible in the rental period; you don't want to spend all your time rushing from one place to another instead of enjoying the ride. If you're riding with a group, make sure everyone is on the same page in terms of route and destination, and plan a few stops along the way to regroup. Finally, get a map or written directions before you set out. I know, it's 2016 and everything is digital... but if you end up in a remote area with no service, or your phone battery dies, it's always good to have a backup plan.

Tip #3: Ride safe. I don't want to be a downer, but as The Motorcycle Lawyer I get plenty of calls from injured people who rented a motorcycle, scooter, or moped on vacation and got injured. If you're headed to a tourist destination, keep in mind that most of the people on the roads will be tourists. They're distracted, or lost, or both, and they might not always be taking care to watch for motorcycles. Be aware of vehicle drivers' lack of awareness, particularly at intersections. It's worth doing some research before you leave to see if there are "problem intersections" in the city you are visiting; I have some of these intersections listed by state on my website www.TheMotorcycleLawyer.com.

Finally, make your trip count. Whether you're going for the entire winter or just a few days, get out and enjoy the wind in your face and see some of the amazing sights this country has to offer. 


Tech Tips By Steve

WINDJAMMIN!

Some of you all may remember the

old windjammer fairings, for the day they were pretty awesome for sure but wow were they heavy and when they got old they rattled like the dickens. They were about the only aftermarket fairing you could get besides a few who were making a Harley batwing shell lookalike that was just that ... a shell and you had to figure out how to mount it to whatever you wanted it on. The Windjammer was built to fit the bike and came with all the mounting hardware needed, cool deal. Today, there are a crazy amount of options and styles to pick from, some are shells and some are complete with awesome stereos already installed and painted to match your bike ready for install.

We are going to install a couple of styles of wind jamming devices onto a Yamaha V-Max today, one universal tinted sport shield and one Memphis Shades café' style sport fairing.



Our test subject all ready for a facelift.

First is the sport shield, this one is super easy to install with the universal handlebar mounts. It has a huge amount of adjustment to make sure it clears things and tilts back too, so it does not stick out like an eye sore. It small, but makes a huge difference on the road and keeps the bugs off ya at night, especially during June bug season! Simply install the mounts onto the Plexiglas, then clamp on the mounts to the handlebars and adjust as you like ... Done!

All mounted and adjusted to fit, easy day.

Ok now for the fun, if you are already going to Memphis Shades and looking for the Café Sport Fairing and Mounts for the V-Max, stop ... they don't make any mounts for the V-Max, however that never stopped me before! I did a little shimming and BAM I took some mounts for a Honda and made them work perfectly for this bike. First, take all the mounting hardware out (be very careful the little mounting buttons scratch very easily, yes I scratched one). Once you have everything out, take the small rubber grommets and put them in the fairing, then mount the guick attack brackets to the fairing. Once you have that on, put it up to the bike and have someone lightly mark where you want the clamps to go on the forks as you position the fairing where it looks good to you. Once the clamps are on, but NOT tight, do a test fit of the fairing. If you like everything, snug the clamps down, remove the fairing and tighten everything down. Refit to make sure everything is golden and you are done. Remember, I said ours was a bit of a custom job right? Well, the stock turn signals will not work with this fairing, lucky the owner wanted to go with some cool LEDs anyway. One more note: We have installed a few of these Memphis Shades Café Fairings and the paint is less than stellar, not horrible, but you might want to repaint it even if you are keeping it black
