





New GI Bill Passes Senate

Lawmakers on Capitol Hill have unanimously passed legislation to make major changes to education benefits for military veterans. Now all that's left is for President Trump to sign it into law — and the White House says he will.

The Harry W. Colmery Veterans Education Assistance Act of 2017 has garnered strong bipartisan support in Congress, where law-makers have worked to fast-track the bill to the president's desk. Senators passed the legislation by voice vote, less than three weeks after the Forever GI Bill, as it's become known, was introduced in the House of Representatives.

The new GI Bill would bring significant changes to the current law passed in 2008. Among its most popular provisions are the elimination — for veterans who left the military in 2013 or later — of a 15-year use-or-lose rule, as well as the expansion of benefits for reservists, Purple Heart recipients and surviving dependents. It would also restore GI Bill benefits to veterans impacted by school closures since 2015 and allocate more funds for college degree programs in the science, technology, engineering and math fields.

If the Forever GI Bill becomes law, some of the provisions would take effect Jan. 1, 2018. Others would start next August, and others — like granting active-duty service members eligibility for the Yellow Ribbon Program — would not apply for a few more years.

A White House spokesman said the president intends to sign the legislation, but it's not clear when.

The updated version of the bill calls for slight reductions in the monthly housing allowances for new GI Bill enrollees to pay for the estimated \$3 billion cost of the benefits expansion. The 1 percent reductions would take place over five years.

VSO leaders celebrated the bill's passage and praised Congress for its bipartisan efforts.

"The Forever GI Bill is proof that even a divided nation can come together to support our veterans and their families," said Got Your 6 Director of Government Relations Lauren Augustine. "This comprehensive bill will provide millions of current and future veterans and their loved ones the peace of mind knowing the education benefits they've earned are secure."

Michigan sailor killed in Pearl Harbor attack laid to rest after 76 years

U.S. Navy sailor Fred M. Jones has finally been laid to rest. Aboard the USS Oklahoma when it was attacked by Japanese fighter

planes on the morning of Dec. 7, 1941 in Pearl Harbor, the 30-yearold Otter Lake resident went missing in action.

He was a Machinist's Mate First Class aboard the Oklahoma when it sunk, leading to the death of 429 crew members.

Jones was transferred to the Oklahoma in May 1939 from the USS Case after having been aboard the USS Chaumont, USS Mindanao, USS Cincinnati, USS Colorado, USS Simpson and USS Noa, per a transcript of his Naval service.

"It's so overwhelming. All the people on the parade route and here, the respect -- it's truly overwhelming," said Helen Kellie Cosner. "I've always been so proud of my grandfather. Throughout my life, I told anyone who would listen. I don't have the words to tell you how happy this makes me. Truly, this is an honor."

It took decades of searching, but the U.S. Navy was finally able to identify his remains after the use of DNA testing with Jones' family members in the mid-Michigan area.

Great-niece Sue Nichols helped organize a funeral service with graveside military honors that took place Saturday, May 20 at Lakeside Cemetery in Port Huron after his casket was escorted from Detroit Metropolitan Airport.

More than 300 people, family members, police and veterans attended to show their respects for Jones.

The Motorcycle Lawyer on THE LAW BLACK BOXES IN MOTOR VEHICLES AND CRASHES

You've probably heard about the infamous black box in airplanes. It's also called an EDR, short for Event Data Recorder. The black box is essentially a computer that's built to survive a crash and preserves factual data from the airplane. This data then allows investigators to better understand what caused the airplane to crash.

What you might not know is that many cars, and even some motorcycles, now have EDRs built into them.

Unlike the black boxes in airplanes, EDRs in vehicles usually don't record data continuously. Instead, they're triggered when certain pre-crash conditions are met. The EDRs in vehicles record the 5 or so seconds before impact.

The data that EDRs record varies from manufacturer to manufacturer, but in general they record the speed of the car, whether or not the driver is wearing a seatbelt, airbag deployment, brake status, and throttle position.

The information that EDRs preserve has been used by police during vehicle investigations and in court to determine who is at fault.

Recently, EDRs have been placed in several motorcycles, notably the Kawasaki Ninja line and the Honda Gold Wing Airbag model from 2006-2014. Many of the motorcycle EDRs record the same kind of data that those in cars do, minus the seatbelt and airbag data

Usually, EDRs will record the speed of a motorcycle, the throttle position, brake status, and the severity of the crash.

I have seen EDR data in use in cases I have litigated. I had a case where the car that turned left in front of my client's motorcycle and killed him had an EDR. The defense expert attempted to use the car's EDR information to argue that the motorcyclist was speeding.

While there is some information that may allow an insight into a range of speed of the other vehicle, in this case, my client's motorcycle, there's still room for error, as this defense attorney learned.

The EDR captures what is called a "crash pulse". The nature of the crash pulse is in the form of the vehicle's velocity change from a crash. The defense attorney was trying to take the crash pulse of the car and use it to show that my client - the motorcyclist - was speeding.

However, I had four eyewitnesses that said the motorcyclist wasn't speeding. In fact, there was a driver behind my client who says he was the pacing the motorcycle and testified that he looked at his speedometer, so he knew exactly how fast my client was going.

The defense then brought in an expert to try and sell the jury on his opinion as to what he interpreted from the car's EDR. He attempted to convince the jury that the EDR painted the whole picture of the crash and that the eyewitnesses were mistaken.

To prepare for cross-examining him, I interviewed an expert who teaches and mentors professionals on EDR technology. I brought up the points that the defense's expert used in his testimony. This EDR expert's comment was, "He's definitely cheating and fudging the analysis to make a huge jump to get to motorcycle speed."

While EDRs are helpful for understanding what happened in its car right before, during, and after a crash, they only offer one side of the story. When paid-for experts try to use the EDR data to extrapolate what other vehicles were doing at the time of the crash, tread carefully. You're likely not getting an accurate picture of what happened.

IN THE SHOP WITH RON

LOVE THEM JUGS

Now that I have everyone's attention, this month in the shop we will be installing a set of Love Jugs electric cooling fans on a 205 H-D Road King. Most Harley-Davidson motorcycle motors are air cooled, meaning air circulating over and around the motor and cooling fins on the cylinders and heads is how the motor is kept at a safe operating temperature. Motor oil and proper fuel delivery also play an important role in keeping the motor cool. But for this article, we will focus mainly on the air flow for cooling purposes. Logic would suggest that if air is used to cool the motor, more air = more cooling. Constant air flow helps dissipate the heat caused by the internal combustion of the motor so at highway speeds air flow keeps the motor at a safe operating temperature. But, obviously it's impossible to keep the motorcycle at highway speeds at all times. Back roading, heavy traffic, stop and go traffic and in town riding can cause high operating temperatures. On an air cooled motor HEAT is public enemy #1. The folks at Love Jugs/Cool Master have designed a product specifically to combat this situation - Love Jugs electric cooling fans. I have heard of overhaul operating temperature drops of between 60 and 95 degrees Fahrenheit. That's a substantial temperature drop on an air cooled motor. So let's get to it. Any time I install a kit like this the first thing I do is get everything out of the box, lay out all the parts out, familiarize yourself with them make sure nothing was left out.



They also make an anti-vibration kit to help keep the fans from vibrating too much.



The directions are pretty straight forward and well written. The first step is to unplug the horn wires and remove the acorn nut holding the horn and mounting bracket to the bracket on the frame and set it aside. Next, the directions recommend assembling the parts on a bench as much as possible. Remove the horn from the mounting bracket previously removed from the bike and install it on the new bracket that the fans are mounted to. There is some adjustment here and you want to center the horn between the fans and make sure it's straight and level before final tightening.



Now we can assemble the anti-vibration kit on the bench also. Once assembled mount the anti-vibration kit to the existing horn mount bracket on the frame of the motorcycle.



I recommend installing all parts and checking the alignment and clearance of all parts before final tight-ening. At this time I like to route the wiring and make sure everything lines up as it should. The fans come prewired with a four pin connector on the end of the wiring from the fans.



If you have a late model touring bike with a fairing it may have an accessory switch already installed, but

not being used. If that is the case, there should be a plug under the right side cover that this plug will plug into and with the accessory switch turned on it will power the fans. If you have an older bike or one without a fairing, directions recommend cutting the plug off the end of the fan wiring and connecting directly to battery. Black wire to the negative post on battery. Red wire to the positive post with a 15 amp in line fuse between the battery and the main power wire from the fans. The fans are controlled by switches on the fans. In either case, when routing the wiring be sure it's not going to get pinched or be near any heat source. The manufacturer recommends trying the fan assemblies with and without the anti-vibration kit and with and without the extra rubber washer on the bracket to see which set up causes the fans to



Once you're satisfied with everything, use Loctite blue on all the fasteners and tighten securely. Connect all wiring and route in a safe manner. When connecting directly to the battery, the fans will run even with the bike ignition turned off and if left on it could cause the battery to run down. Make sure to turn the fans off when the bike is turned off. The manufacturer recommends leaving the fans on anytime the bike is running except at highway speeds. If you do a lot of in town stop and go riding, this might be something that could help lower the operating temperature of your bikes motor.

IT AIN'T YOUR GREAT **GREAT GRANDDADDY'S BUFFALO GUN. BUT...**




